This is a non-traditional drilling unit. Members may be required to attend drills that consist of MUTA 8 and or MUTA 12. Additionally, members are required to have or get a Secret Clearance.

Prerequisites for Course 2E-SI5P/SQIP/011-SQIP (Airborne)

- Must be less than 36 years of age on ATRRS report date. General Officers, Field Grade Officers, Warrant's in grade W-3 thru W-5, and Enlisted E-5 and above may be considered for a waiver of age upon examining medical officer recommendation.
- Must meet physical qualification for parachute duty established in AR 40-501. Weigh a minimum of 105 pounds when screened IAW AR 600-9. Male/Female must pass APFT with a score of 180 points (60 in each event using 17-21 year age scale), complete one flexed-arm hang for 20 sec's, and meet height/weight standard IAW AR 600-9. APFT administered the first day of airborne course. Failure of the APFT constitutes a failure of the entrance exam and will be out-processed from the course. Students are afforded 10 minutes of rest before retest on pushups, sit-ups, or the flexed-arm hang, and 20 minutes of rest is afforded before retaking the run event.
- MOS reclassification will occur as appropriate for initial entry Soldiers. USMA Cadets must complete Cadet Basic Training. ROTC cadets must be under scholarship or contracted. Enlisted personnel must have completed Basic Combat Training, OSUT, or other service equivalent training. Commanders selecting personnel to attend the Airborne Course will refer to AR 614-110, for Officers and AR 614-200, for Enlisted.
