



CHAPTER 33 (POST 9/11) GI BILL® TUITION & FEES – PRIVATE, FOR-PROFIT, OR FOREIGN INSTITUTION

The Chapter 33 GI Bill®, pays tuition & fees directly to the educational institution based on the student's applicable Chapter 33 tier rate.

Estimating Payments

1. Identify the applicable Chapter 33 tier rate.
2. Using a calculator, enter the tuition & fees (1 term only).
 - Your school may have a separate table for online students.
3. Deduct any Federal-based aid or assistance (excluding loans & Title IV funds) that are provided directly to the institution and specifically designed strictly for tuition & fees.
 - i.e. \$17,324 - \$4,000 (Federal Tuition Assistance via GoArmyEd) = \$13,324.
4. Multiply this amount by the applicable Chapter 33 tier rate to identify what will be covered.
 - i.e. \$13,324 x 0.60 (60%) = \$7,994.40 (covered by Chapter 33).
5. Using the final amount identified in step 3, subtract what Chapter 33 will cover to identify your out-of-pocket costs.
 - i.e. \$13,324 – 7,994.40 (covered by Chapter 33) = \$5,329.60 (covered by student).
 - Cap for tuition & fees is
 - Academic year 2019-2020: \$24,476.79/year.
 - Academic year 2020-2021 \$25,162.14/year (effective 01 August 2020).
 - The U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) will either pay the total or the cap, whichever is less.
 - This is only an estimate. The VA will identify the official determination when the Certificate of Eligibility (COE) is issued to the student after they apply to receive benefits.
