CHIEF MASTER SERGEANT MICHAEL D. STANLEY

Chief Master Sergeant Michael D. Stanley is the Command Chief Master Sergeant of Joint Forces Headquarters, North Carolina National Guard, Raleigh, North Carolina. He advises the Adjutant General and the Assistant Adjutant General, Air on matters influencing the health, welfare, morale and effective utilization of the state's more than 1400 enlisted airmen.

Chief Stanley entered the Air Force in 1982 and served as a Fuels Specialist. He has participated in Operations El Dorado Canyon, Desert Shield, Noble Eagle and Enduring Freedom. He served seven years on active duty in several stateside and overseas assignments. Chief Stanley transferred to the Air Force Reserves in 1989 where he continued his service as a Fuels Specialist. In 1992, he joined the North Carolina Army National Guard as a Petroleum Laboratory Specialist. In 1995, he joined the North Carolina Air National Guard, 145th Airlift Wing as a Fuels Specialist. In 2008 Chief Stanley was selected to serve as the First Sergeant for the 145th Logistics Readiness Squadron. In 2011, he was selected to serve as the 145th Airlift Wing First Sergeant. In March 2013 he was appointed as the Fuels Manager. He was promoted to Chief Master Sergeant 1 October 2013 and assumed his present duties on 1 December 2014.
